Public Comment (Non-Action items): Public comment on non- action agenda items shall be received during the designated portion of the agenda. Comments shall be limited to no more than three (3) minutes for all non-action agenda items.

Waiver Warning: If you challenge decisions/direction of the City Council of the City of Cotati in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at public hearing(s) described in this agenda, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Cotati at, or prior to, the public hearing(s).

It is recommended that the City Council adopt a resolution approving the 2017 City of Cotati Summer Movies in the Park and National Night Out events in La Plaza Park; authorizing the temporary street closure of La Plaza and the sales of food by vendors and food trucks.

- B. APPROVAL OF FARMERS MARKET EVENT IN LA PLAZA PARK TO BE HELD EVERY THURSDAY FROM JUNE 1ST THROUGH AUGUST 31ST, 2017 IN LA PLAZA PARK**

It is recommended that the City Council adopt a resolution approving an event for Agricultural Community Events Farmers Markets to be held every Thursday evening from June 1st through August 31st, 2017 in La Plaza Park; authorizing the temporary street closure of La Plaza, the use of amplified live entertainment, sales of food by vendors and food trucks, the sales of alcoholic beverages in La Plaza Park for the Markets, and subsidizing limited staff costs in connection therewith.

It is recommended the City Council adopt a resolution accepting the Old Redwood Highway South Preservation Project improvements, authorizing the City Clerk to file the Notice of Completion, and authorizing the release of retention.

D. INTENT TO RENEW JOINT POWERS AGREEMENT FOR THE HUD FUNDING 2018-2020 QUALIFICATION PERIOD

It is recommended that the City Council of the City of Cotati authorize the City Manager to sign the certification declaring the intent to remain an eight jurisdiction urban county for 2018-2020 and thereby exercising the automatic three-year renewal feature in the existing JPA.
